Act 82 (S.133) An act relating to examining mental health care and care coordination

### **Introduction:**

On July 25 and August 17, 2017, the Department of Mental Health will facilitate discussions regarding the requirements in Section 3 and Section 4 of Act 82 to produce an "Analysis, Action Plan, and Long-Term Vision for the Provision of Mental Health Care Within the Health Care System". Several pieces within these two sections requires a draft analysis by September 1, 2017. The goal is to use this time to develop the draft analysis and further define the work that needs to take place from September 1 – December 15, 2017 when the final analysis is due. Other components of Act 82, such as Involuntary Meds, will be addressed at a later date.
