

RE: Age of CRT Clients at the end of FY2012

This week's PIP supplements our January 4, 2013, report on length of service of Community Rehabilitation and Treatment (CRT) Program clients by providing information regarding the age of the 2,494 individuals who were enrolled in CRT programs for adults with serious and persistent mental illness at the end of state fiscal year 2012. This analysis was conducted in response to a request from Peggy Brozicevic, Research & Statistics Chief in the Vermont Department of Health, for information regarding the age distribution of CRT service recipients that could be useful for interpreting the findings of the previous report.

Individual age is calculated as of the end of the fiscal year. Analysis is based on Monthly Service Report (MSR) data submitted to the Vermont Department of Mental Health (DMH) by designated community agencies (DAs) for FY2012.




As you will see, the age of Vermont CRT service recipients at the end of FY2012 varied from 18 to 95 years, with the greatest proportion in the 50-64 age group (44%), followed by the 35-49 age group (28%) and the 18-34 age group (15%).

There were relatively small differences among DAs in the average age of CRT service recipients served at the end of FY2012, varying from highs of more than 51 years of age at WCMH, UCS, and RMHS to lows of 48 years at HC, LCMH, and HCRS.
