
RE: Residence of MH/SA Inpatients by Hospital CY2008

This week's PIP report focuses on the county of residence of adults who received mental health or substance abuse services during CY2008 by the Vermont State Hospital (VSH) and other Vermont hospitals.

This report is based on analysis of anonymous extracts from the Vermont's Uniform Hospital Discharge Data Set and databases maintained by the Vermont State Hospital and the Brattleboro Retreat.

As you will see, the Vermont State Hospital provided the most inpatient days to residents of six counties (Bennington, Essex, Orange, Orleans, Washington, and Windsor). Fletcher Allen provided the most inpatient days to residents of three counties (Addison, Franklin, and Grand Isle). Two counties, Chittenden and Lamoille, used VSH and Fletcher Allen almost equally.

Local hospitals provided the most inpatient days to three other counties: Rutland Regional Medical Center for Rutland County, Central Vermont Hospital for Caledonia County, and Brattleboro Retreat for Windham County.
