
RE: Age of CRT Clients: FY2003-2012

This week's PIP supplements our previous report<sup>1</sup> regarding age of CRT clients at the end of FY 2012 by providing information regarding the age of CRT clients served during FY2003 – FY2012.

This analysis was conducted in response to a request from Department of Mental Health Policy Director, Nick Nichols, following the publication of the February report.

As in the previous report, analysis is based on Monthly Service Report (MSR) data submitted to the Vermont Department of Mental Health (DMH) by designated community agencies (DAs) for FY2003-FY2012. Age of CRT clients is calculated at the midpoint (December 31<sup>st</sup>) of each fiscal year.


As you will see, the representation of CRT clients in our youngest age group (less than 20 years) and our oldest age group (65 years or older) remained fairly constant during the study period. However, there was substantial variation in the representation of CRT Clients in both the 35-49 age group (decreasing from 40% in 2003 to 29% in 2012) and the 50-64 age group (increasing from 28% in 2003 to 42% in 2012).
