The answers on the demographic questions showed it was largely skewed to higher income (\$50 -75k +), higher formal education level (Masters degree), white and female identifying. • Comment about challenges to accessing timely services and services that are meeting people’s needs “some of the time” • Members would like to be able to view the data and take time to digest it
