- 1. Use of any tobacco product is prohibited on the Vermont Psychiatric Care Hospital (VPCH) Grounds.
- 2. Each patient will be informed of the potential harmful effects of smoking and other uses of tobacco and the hospital will offer the opportunity to participate in a smoking and other tobacco cessation program. Resource materials will be provided to unit-based staff to assist in these education efforts for patients. Those patients who seek specific treatment for smoking and tobacco cessation will be supported in this effort.
- Members of the patient's treatment team will assist the patient to reduce and address any discomfort
 that occurs as a result of smoking and other tobacco cessation. Nicotine replacement materials will be
 prescribed as needed.
- 4. All patients will be required to turn in their cigarettes and other tobacco-related products upon admission; these materials will be returned at discharge.
- 5. Any tobacco product found on Hospital Grounds will be confiscated by staff and returned to the patient at discharge. Visitors are not to provide tobacco products to hospital patients.
