The Department of Mental Health held a public comment listening session on the proposed Urgent Care Project on May 21, 2023. One member of the public attended the hearing but did not offer any public comment. Additionally, no written comments were received by May 25, 2024, following public notice of the hearing and comment period. DMH earlier determined your application, with supplemental responses to questions posed by DMH, to be complete on May 3, 2024. Given this review and the absence of any new information that would identify potential concerns or local opposition to this proposed project, **DMH is pleased to grant Howard Center a Certificate of Approval (COA)** to move forward with this project.
