

<b>River Valley Therapeutic Residence Policy and Procedure</b>		
<b>COVID-19 Employee Screening Policy</b>

## POLICY

It is the goal of River Valley Therapeutic Residence (RVTR) to mitigate the risk of COVID-19 exposure within the facility. RVTR has instituted screening procedures as recommended by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), and the Vermont Department of Health (VDH). This policy will be time limited and the continued necessity for use will be determined by the guidelines the CDC, CMS, and VDH put forth.

## DEFINITIONS

### Personnel:

The (IFC) 86 FR 6155 vaccine requirements applies to any individual who provides any care, treatment, or other services for the facility and/or the individuals it serves, regardless of clinical responsibility or contact with residents including, but not limited to:

- Facility Employees
- Licensed Practitioners
- Students, trainees, volunteers, etc.
- Any individuals who provide care, treatment, or other services for the facility and/or the individuals it serves, under contract or by any other arrangement.


Here after, individuals meeting the above listed criteria are referred to as *personnel*.

## DEFINITIONS

Personnel shall self-screen for symptoms indicative of COVID-19 infection prior to the start of each work shift.

Work clearance determinations should be made utilizing current RVTR Return to Work Guidance.

In accordance with State of Vermont policy and the terms of the Collective Bargaining Agreement, personnel shall notify their direct supervisor or designees if they will be absent from work.
