Re: Response and Questions Pathways COA Application-Dated March 15, 2024

As indicated in our COA application Pathways is seeking increased funding for 8 beds for FY 26. The financial tables provided reflect the purchase and renovation of 141 Maple therefore all project tabs include only capital expenses with the exception of tab 3A. Tab 3A for FY26 and FY27 includes the increase in revenue and expense for 8 beds, however, no details are provided as 3A requires the increase to be included with revenue and expenses for the entire agency. Details on how Pathways prepared the Financial tables is provided on page 8 of the COA application under <u>Financial Tables Notes</u> and note #1 speaks to the increase in the budget and how it was represented in 3A.

Our apologies for any confusion as the required financial tables did not include a table for a draft budget for the bed increase. To further clarify this omission we've included the draft financials for 8 beds vs 5 beds below for your review. The draft budget reflects an increase in services to 8 beds beginning FY26 and in FY27 compared to actual FY24 and FY25 funding. The projected date of construction completion for 141 Maple is currently June of 2025 and the budget increase reflected would not be before FY 26. Please let us know if you'd like us to rework the tables to include these projections more specifically or if you require additional information about the attached.
